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TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR GE PRODUCT

Following terms and conditions, as appropriate, shall apply to PIA purchase order in addition to terms and conditions noted on the purchase order.

1. Product shall be conforming to all applicable specification.
2. Latest revision of all specifications, standards, drawings and other documents applicable to this purchase order shall be applied unless otherwise specifically noted on the purchase order.
3. Product, procedures, equipment and personnel shall have approval as per applicable specification
4. Supplier processes applicable to the purchase order shall have GE approval and list in GE Yellow pages.
5. Quality management system of the supplier shall have accreditation (ISO 9001-2008 or AS9100C) as applicable to the specification.
6. Requirement of test, inspection, verification (including production process verification), and use of statistical tools for product acceptance shall be applied as noted in the specification.
7. Requirements for test specimens (e.g., production method, number, storage conditions) shall be applied as noted in the specification
8. Supplier shall furnish certificate of conformance of all tests and inspections applicable to the purchase order. For forged and wrought material testing reports shall be generated by GE approved lab per S-400 and S-450. The test and inspection result must fulfill the Drawing/Specification requirements
9. Supplier shall notify PEC regarding inadvertent shipment of any nonconforming product. Notification will include shipment detail, date of shipment, condition of nonconformity and nonconforming quantity
10. Supplier shall obtain PEC approval for nonconforming product disposition.
11. Supplier shall notify PEC of changes in product and/or process, changes of suppliers, change of manufacturing facility location and, where required, should obtain approval from PEC.
12. Supplier shall retain all record related to this purchase order for at least 7 years.
13. Right of entry for PEC, its customer's and regulatory authorities' representative to the applicable areas of all facilities at any level of the supply chain, involved in the order, and all applicable records shall be afforded.
14. Supplier is responsible to flow down to the supply chain the applicable requirements including requirement notified by PEC and its customers.
15. Any nonconforming material and/or product received at PEC shall be replaced with conforming material and/or product by the supplier within 30 days of notification of nonconformance from PEC.
16. Supplier shall be liable to pay all damages incurred due to receipt of nonconforming material and/or product
17. Nonconforming material and/or product shall be collected by supplier at his own expense.
